

You need to go food shopping once a week for your family's food for the week. You spend £65.

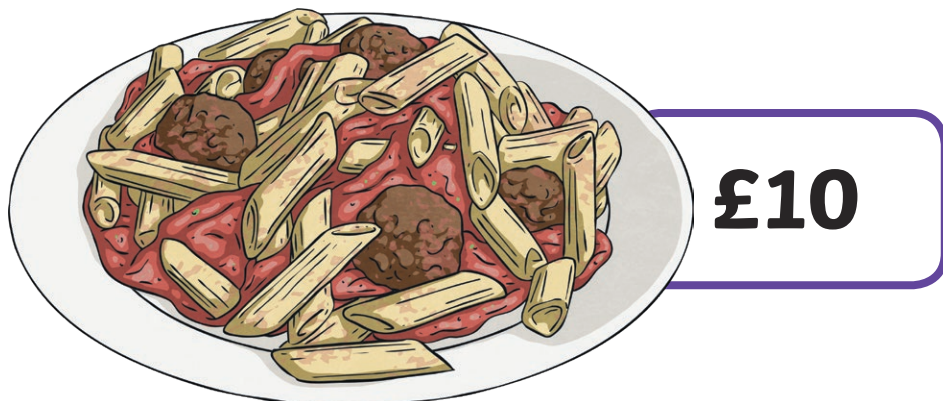


You need to buy your train ticket for travel to work. You buy this every week. You spend £12.

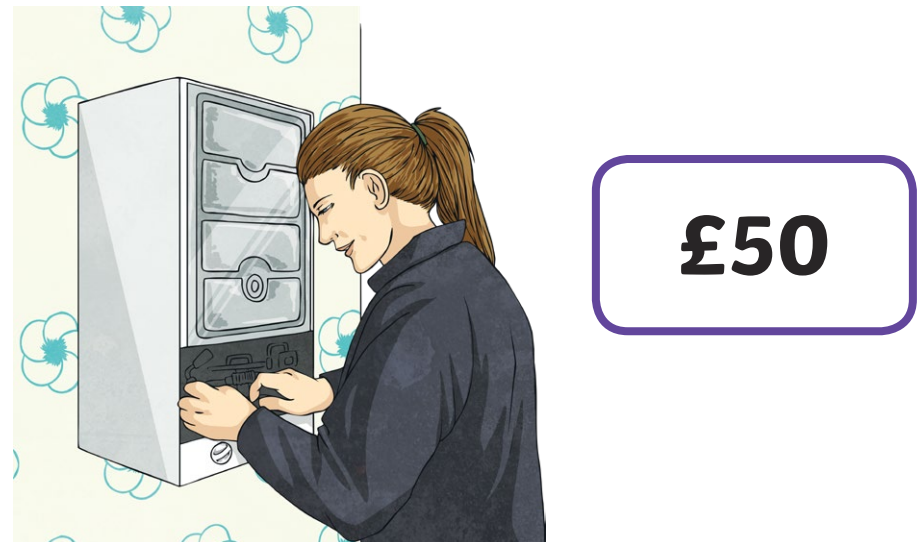
