Arts and Crafts- **DIY Stethoscope**

This week we will be completing activities around 'Our Medical Heroes'. This could be doctors, nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists or health care workers. They are working extremely hard to support the NHS and keep us safe!

Things you will need

- Cardboard
- Tin foil (optional)
- Coloured pens / felts / paint
- Scissors
- Glue / cello tape / stapler (you can use any of these to stick the pieces of the craft together)
- Ribbon



Note to parents: This is a great activity for the children to make their own decisions about their creative process and to develop independence in terms of what equipment they need. You can encourage this by asking them what they might need rather than gathering it for them.

Activity

1. Draw the shape of your stethoscope onto the cardboard then carefully cut it out.
2. Cut ribbon to length and attach to the bottom part of your cardboard.
3. Cut a small circle out of cardboard and attach to the other end of the ribbon.
4. Decorate your stethoscope. You can cover the cardboard in tinfoil or use colours to decorate.
