Sensory Bottles - Activity 2

Things you will need

- Empty plastic bottles or tubs.

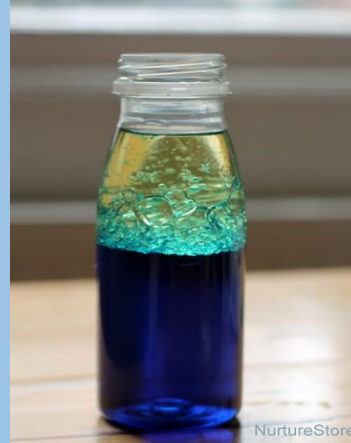
For dry sensory bottles, you can use

- Buttons
- Glitter
- Dried pasta
- Beads
- Pompoms
- Rice
- Sand

For liquid sensory bottles, you will need

- Water
- Food colouring
- Vegetable oil

All equipment can be swapped for something else that is similar based on what you have at home.



Activity

This activity is to help the children use their investigative skills to make enquiries about the world around them. Please encourage the pupils to collect their own equipment where possible.

1. Put a small amount of your choice of dry materials into an empty bottle or re-sealable tub/jar
2. What can you see? Can you describe the colours? You could even add small toys to sand / rice bottles and play hide and seek. How many can you find?

For the liquid sensory bottles

1. Fill half of your bottle with cool water.

2. Add as many drops of your choice of food colouring colour
3. Top up your bottle with vegetable oil
