



Key Stage 2 Home Learning Outdoor Learning Activities:

Painting with water and drawing with chalks.

Activity 1:

Whilst its sunny out, try and paint a picture on the dry pavement using water and a paint brush. You could try drawing a smiley face or a person.

Tip – Be quick and try and finish the drawing before the sun dries it away!

Activity 2:

If you want to draw something which lasts a little longer, try using chalks. You can attempt to draw a rainbow for our NHS Heroes on the pavement. If you can, try to write down a colourful positive message to cheer people up who walk by. For example you could write “Keep smiling”.

Tip – If you want to start again, wash it away with a bucket of water and wait for the pavement to dry in the sun.



Note to parents: Try and support the child in basing there drawings around something positive, to encourage a positive energy for themselves and others. Allowing them to think of what they could write or draw to bring joy to other people.
