Week 4: Our Great Outdoors

This half term we will be completing activities based on our theme of 'Our Great Outdoors'. This week our focus is on bees! We hope that you manage to get outside and enjoy the nice weather. During WW2, honey sandwiches were a popular meal because many other ingredients were difficult to buy due to rationing. You are going to make your very own honey sandwich. You can use the sequencing worksheet before you make your sandwich so you have a step-by-step guide to help you make it.

How to Make a Honey Sandwich

Complete the instructions by adding the pictures, showing how to make a honey sandwich.

1. First, get two slices of bread.
2. Next, use the knife to spread some butter onto both slices.
3. After that, use a knife to spread the honey on top of the butter, on one of the slices of bread.
4. Then, put one slice of bread on top of the other, to make a sandwich.
5. After that, cut the sandwich in half with the knife.
6. Finally, eat it!



Note to parents:

This is a History based activity. The aim is for the children to understand the concept of rationing during WW2 and try a simple meal from during that time.
