<p>Use Google Earth to find your local police station and fire station. Can you ask questions to members of your family to find out what happens at these places? Maybe you could take a 'screen shot' when you have found them and label them using the computer.</p>  <p>Note to parents: this is a Geography based activity where the children can find out more about their local area and have access to aerial view maps.</p>	<p>Our community heroes need to eat lunch! Design and make a packed lunch that a community hero would enjoy. Think about including foods from the healthy eating plate.</p>  <p>Note to parents: This is a Food Technology based activity. The aim is for the children to design and create a healthy packed lunch.</p> <p>An example of a healthy eating plate can be found under the "DT Tab" on the website.</p>
Activity 3 - DT	Activity 4 - Science
<p>Cut out a template of a community hero. Use a glue stick to glue the tabs together to form a cone.</p>  <p>Note to parents: This is a DT based activity. You will need to print out the people who help us cones and have a pair of scissors and glue stick ready.</p> <p>People who help us cones can be found under the "DT Tab" on the website.</p>	<p>Draw around your hero and label the different body parts. As an extension, label as many of the internal organs as you can!</p>  <p>Note to parents: This is a Science based activity.
