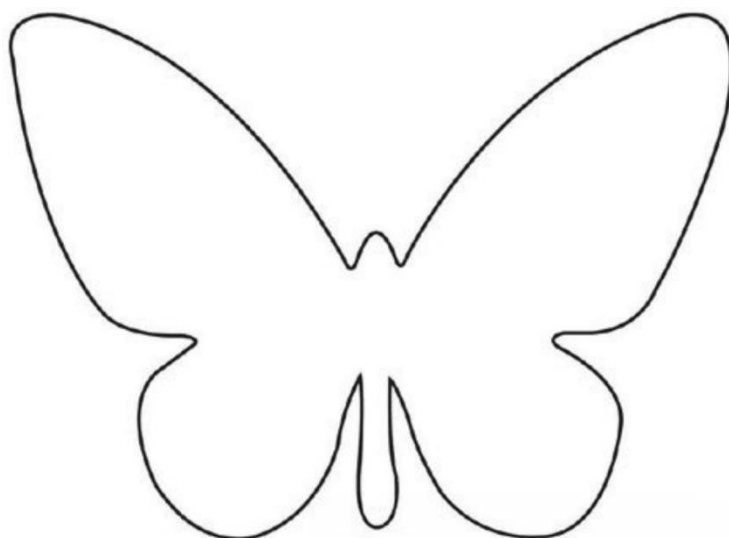
Week 3: Our Great Outdoors
