



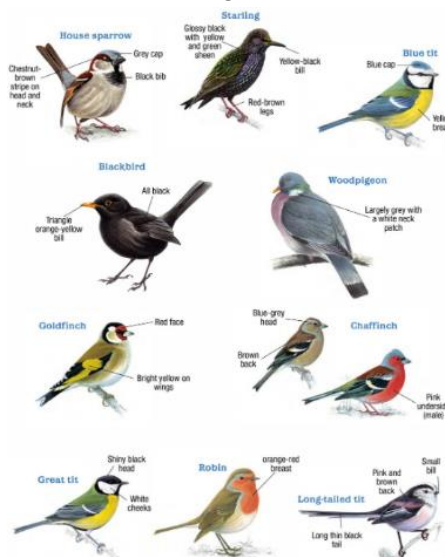
## KS2 RE Activity

### Week 2: Our Great Outdoors

This half term we will be completing activities based on our theme of 'Our Great Outdoors'. This week our focus is on our gardens! We hope that you manage to get out in your garden and enjoy the nice weather. If you could ask your parents to e-mail pictures of your fabulous work to your class teacher so that it can be shared in the newsletter it would be greatly appreciated.

#### Making a drinking tray for birds:

1. Ask a grown up to help you make a small hole in the yoghurt pot about 1cm from the rim.
2. Fill the pot with cold water and put the plant pot tray on top.
3. Very carefully and holding on tightly, turn the two, still pushed together, so that the yoghurt pot is now upside down. The water will flow into the tray and will stop at the level of the hole in the yoghurt pot.
4. As the birds have a drink the water will refill from inside the yoghurt pot.
5. Watch and see which birds come to drink the water. Discuss with a family member how supporting wildlife makes you feel and the reasons it's a positive thing as animals have rights too.



Note to parents:

This is an RE based activity. The aim is for the children to create a drinking tray for birds and potentially other small wildlife in your garden/outdoor area to drink from. The idea behind this is for the child to think about why it's good to support your local outdoor environment/wildlife as animals have rights too.
