Messy Play activity- **Nature art bugs**

Here is an activity that has so many possible creative outcomes and can be achieved from using items found out and about on a walk or maybe in your garden.

Things you will need

- A tub or bag to collect resources in
- An adult to take you out and about
- Paper to use as a backdrop for your art bug (can use the floor)
- PVA glue (not essential but you could glue your nature art bug to keep onto your paper)

Activity

This activity allows some daily exercise and an element of fun by looking out for interesting twigs, leaves etc to create your bug.

1. Firstly arrange your findings on a surface (table/floor) so you can see what you have to work with.
2. Decide if you wish to create your art directly on the surface or if you will use paper.
3. Play around until you are happy with how your bug looks.
4. Be creative the possibilities are endless...make a family of bugs, maybe make a different animal a fox, cat or even a dinosaur.
5. Most importantly there is no right or wrong way and have fun.
