Arts and Crafts- **Superhero cuffs**

This week we will be completing activities around 'We are Heroes.' You have all done an amazing job by staying in your homes, following government advice and helping to keep everyone safe. **You are Heroes!**

Things you will need

- Toilet rolls x 2 (or kitchen roll)
- Coloured pencils / felt tips
- Coloured card (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue / cello tape / stapler (you can use any of these to stick the pieces of the cuffs together)



Activity

This activity is to practice drawing, cutting and fine motor skills. Please encourage the pupils to collect their own equipment where possible.

Superman cuffs

Begin by covering your toilet rolls in blue coloured paper. You can have your child colour the toilet roll blue using coloured pencils too.

For the Superman logo- Cut a yellow triangle and attach it to the paper toilet roll with the glue stick.

Roughly draw and carefully cut a letter 'S' for Superman then attach it to the yellow triangle.

Batman cuffs

Begin by covering your toilet rolls in black coloured paper. You can have your child colour the toilet roll black using coloured pencils too.

For the Batman logo- Cut a yellow circle and attach it to the paper toilet roll with the glue stick.

Roughly draw a bat shape on the back of a black piece of paper, cut it out carefully using the scissors and attach it over the yellow circle.

Once you allow the cuffs to dry, simply cut the toilet roll down the back and fit it over your child's arm.
