Arts and Crafts- **Superhero mask**

This week we will be completing activities around 'We are Heroes.' You have all done an amazing job by staying in your homes, following government advice and helping to keep everyone safe. **You are Heroes!**

Things you will need

- White, round paper plate
- Pencil
- Blue colouring pencil / felt pen / paint
- Black felt tip / crayon / pencil
- Scissors
- Ribbon or lolly stick
- Cello tape
- Stapler (optional)



Activity

This activity is to practice drawing, cutting and fine motor skills. Please encourage the pupils to collect their own equipment where possible.

1. First, cut the paper plate to fit your face.
2. Next, draw two eye holes with a pencil and carefully cut these out.
3. Then, draw a border around the two eye shapes with a pencil- This space will stay white.
4. Now, colour or paint the whole mask in a colour of your choice- remember to leave the white border around the eye holes.
5. Once your mask is dry, use a black felt tip or coloured pencil to draw a web design on the front of your mask.
6. Finally, you may want to attach a lolly stick to the bottom of the mask using cello tape. Alternatively, you could use ribbon fixed in places using sticky tape or a stapler.
