

It is important to ...

- Always wear gloves.
- Always wash your hands after touching the soil.
- Keep the soil away from your nose and mouth. Never taste or smell the soil!



Soil Sample from...	My Observations
<p><b>See</b></p> <p>You can look through a glass at the soil layers and colours. Use a magnifying glass to look for details. A sieve can be used to separate the soil.</p>	
<p><b>Feel</b></p> <p>You can rub the soil in your hands or between your fingers.</p>	
<p><b>Hear</b></p> <p>You can hear what the soil sounds like when it is rubbed onto paper, cardboard or between your fingers.</p>
