Ref: School-funded private music tuition for KS3 students

It is with great excitement that I am writing to you about an opportunity for additional music tuition that the school has arranged.

This year we have engaged with two music research projects: the Clem Burke Drumming Project and the Furthering Talent Project from Resonate, the Music Education Hub for Liverpool. The impact of both of these projects has been hugely positive on the students involved.

As a result, the school has been working with Resonate and, from September 2022, our Key Stage 3 students will be able to opt for private music tuition onsite during their school day.

We will be offering the following lessons:

- Drums
- Keyboard
- Vocal tuition
- Guitar

Some students have already stated, through a student survey, that they are very interested in this opportunity, whilst others have indicated that it is not something they would wish to pursue at this time. We appreciate their honesty, as it is important that those signing up to lessons are committed to attending well and giving their best effort when in the lessons.

We will strive to give any student interested as much tuition time as possible but the organisation of the sessions will depend on demand. Due to this being the case, it might mean that some students get more tuition time than others, should some disciplines prove more popular than others.

If demand is too high to give all students a full year of tuition, we will form a waiting list and offer tuition for two terms of the year, with priority being given to Year 9, 8 and 7 respectively.
