

Abbot's Lea School Year 7 catch up funding Plan 2019 - 20 During the academic year 2019-20 spending will be focussed on intervention for learners requiring individual support for Literacy, Numeracy and Science to be further embedded across the school, mostly with the support of the pupil premium.

In addition to the pupil premium, the school received an extra grant of £9,100 to support pupil's in Year 7 who had not achieved their, at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2). Part of this focussed intervention was specifically targeted the schools Year 7 pupils who had yet to achieved their age related expectations in reading and or maths.

This additional funding will be used to supplement staffing and enable pupils to get additional 1 to 1 assistance in lessons as necessary.

Total Year 7 catch up funding grant for 2019-20	£9,100

The overall impact of the Year 7 Catch up Funding on progress and achievement will be:

- Improvements in literacy for year 7 students in line with their personal targets, which will be mapped through the progress monitoring of the students and also interventions put into place to support this, including engagement in the Reading Quality Mark.
- Improvements in numeracy for year 7 students in line with their personal targets, which will be mapped through the progress monitoring of the students and also interventions put into place to support this, including the engagement in the Maths Quality Mark.
- Improvements in science for year 7 students in line with their personal targets, which will be
 mapped through the progress monitoring of the students and also interventions put into place
 to support this, which will include an evaluation of the science offer and mapping of a bespoke
 curriculum.
