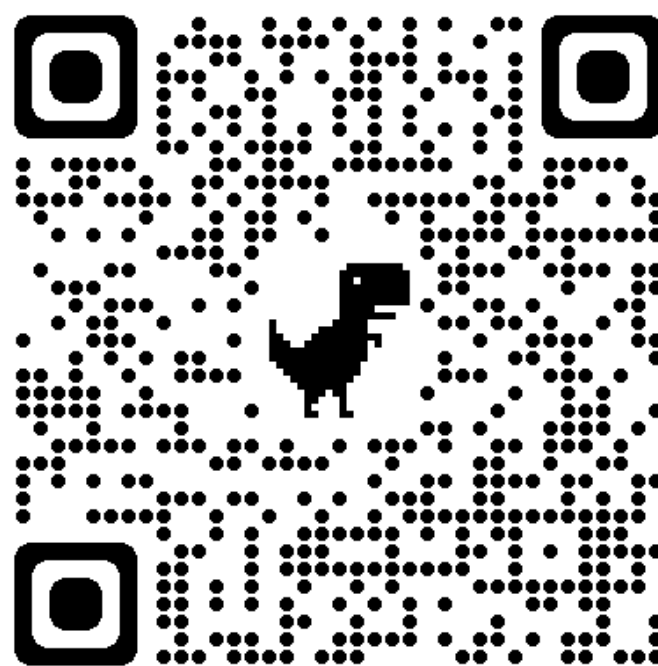


## Lit in Colour
