## Ref: Proposed residential trip to Winmarleigh Hall

I write to inform you of next year's planned Residential Trip to a specialist activity course at PGL Winmarleigh Hall Multi Activity Centre.

Abbot's Lea School has secured funding to offer all students subsidised spaces, in order to make the trip accessible to all students who wish to attend. The original cost of the visit was  $\pounds 270$  but with our subsidy the visit will now cost  $\pounds 160!$ 

We would therefore like to offer this opportunity to the students of the following key stages (as of September 2025):

- Key Stage 2 Wednesday, 4 March 2026 Friday, 6 March 2026 Total Cost - £160
- Key Stage 3 Wednesday, 4 March 2026 Friday, 6 March 2026 *Total Cost - £160*
- Key Stage 4 Wednesday, 25 February 2026 Friday, 27 February 2026 Total Cost - £160
- Key Stage 5 Wednesday, 25 February 2026 Friday, 27 February 2026 Total Cost - £160

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The total cost includes evening accommodation for 2 nights, with 3 days of fun filled activities. All food and snacks are included, along with transport to and from Winmarleigh Hall.

For students in our EYFS/KS1 and Bespoke Provisions, we will provide alternative onsite opportunities.

- Students in Year 2 transitioning to Adapted National Curriculum classrooms in Key Stage 2 will be invited to join the residential next year. This applies to students who are in Year 2 and currently in France class.
- Students in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2, along with those enrolled in our Bespoke program, will be offered a customised trip designed to meet their interests and needs. Further details will be provided shortly. This applies to students currently in Italy, Spain, Ireland, Wales, Portugal and Seychelles classes.

The deadline for securing of places and payment of the non-refundable deposit of £40 per student, is due to the school by 28 April 2025 and will be payable via Arbor.

The remainder of the payments needs to be settled by 28 September 2025, and families will be able to pay in flexibly, as long as the total amount due is in our account by 28 September 2025.

As mentioned above, should your decision or circumstances change after the payment of the deposit, that deposit is non-refundable. If similar change of circumstances occurs after any further payments are made or after the 28 September 2025, and the child doesn't attend, or attends only part of the trip, the costs would not be refundable.
