Although we will not be allowing students to go into the sea for safety reasons, it would be helpful for your child to bring spare footwear or socks if you feel this may be an issue for them.

We ask that all students bring a packed lunch and, if possible, a picnic mat or something to sit on. For students who usually have a school dinner, a packed lunch will be provided by school.

There is no cost for this trip.

Bringing a small amount of money is not necessary, but optional, in case there is an opportunity to buy a drink or snack.
