Dear Families,

Re: Peru Class Educational Visit – World Museum and Strawberry Field

We are delighted to share that students in Peru Class will be taking part in an educational visit to The World Museum, Liverpool, and Strawberry Field on Wednesday 24 June 2026.

This visit has been carefully planned to support several areas of our curriculum and provide students with meaningful real-world learning experiences. During our visit to the World Museum, students will revisit their learning about different cultures and communities through the museum's World Cultures Gallery, including exhibits that explore Islamic art, culture, and artefacts from the Middle East and surrounding regions.

Following our museum visit, we will travel to Strawberry Field, where students will enjoy a picnic lunch and explore the woodland nature reserve. This part of the day will support learning across several curriculum areas. Students will have opportunities to develop their understanding of microhabitats and the natural environment through observation and exploration. In addition, they will practise important life skills by independently ordering and purchasing a drink and snack, supporting their confidence in handling money, making choices, and communicating with members of the public.

These experiences will also support key aspects of students' EHCP targets, including communication, independence, community access, social interaction, and the development of functional life skills.

We will leave school at approximately 9:30am and return by 1:30pm.

Please ensure your child attends school in their full school uniform. Depending on the weather forecast, students may also require a sun hat. If appropriate, please apply sun cream before your child comes to school.

Students who usually receive a school dinner will be provided with a packed lunch by school. Students who usually bring their own lunch should bring a packed lunch as normal.

To support the life skills element of the visit, **we ask that students bring £6 in cash in a labelled envelope by Tuesday 23 June 2026**. This money will be kept securely by the class team and used by students to purchase a drink and snack whilst at Strawberry Field. Any change will be returned home with students on the same day.
